POPE JOHN PAUL II HIGH SCHOOL

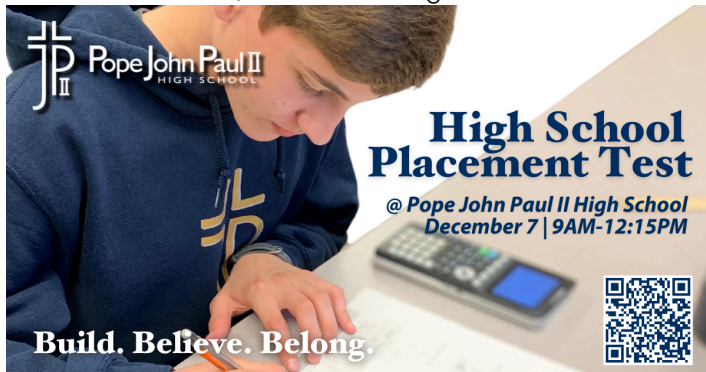
On November 13th, the ambassadors from JPPII visited our 6th-8th grade students. While they were here, they talked with our middle school students about their school, and they answered any questions that our students had about JPPII.

PLACEMENT TESTING

The HSPT is a standardized test administered to 8th graders that helps schools know where to place students academically when they enter high school. The test takes approximately three hours to complete and an essay will be administered after the standardized portion of the test.

We host a Prospective Parent Information Session during the first hour of the HSPT for parents and guardians. The HSPT can be shared with any school that accepts the HSPT regardless of where it was proctored.

The cost of the test is \$30 which can be paid online for anyone with a JPPII FinalSite account, or via cash/check on the day of the test. Registration is required and can be accessed via the QR code to the right.
