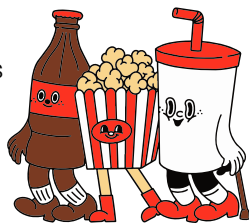
Our current Chapel offering will be going towards buying turkeys for families in need for Thanksgiving.

Our assembly will include songs from our Pre-K PM, Jr K, and K-8th grade students.



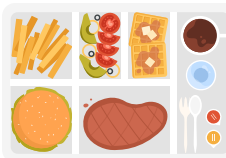
We will have a slideshow of some of the Veterans in our community, US Air Force Honor Guard, guest speaker, and more.

Join our Faith Lutheran Youth Group for a devotion, games, and snacks in the community center.

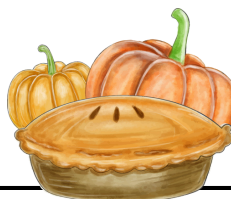

MORNING DROP OFF CHANGE

We will no longer post a staff person at the gravel drive at the front of the line to control the flow of incoming traffic in the morning. The number of cars is low enough that we believe this is not necessary.

Please enter the drive lanes as you normally do. All cars should enter through the gravel drive in the morning. At 8:15am (please not earlier) when you are at the front of the line, pause to be sure it looks clear and carefully proceed forward to the drop off zone for your child. Please, please drive slowly and carefully and keep a lookout for cars and pedestrians as you pull forward.
