



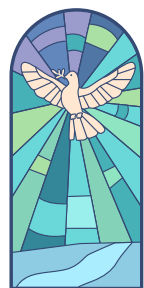

May 19th - 23rd

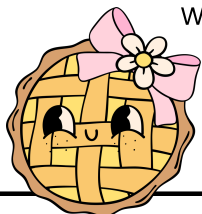

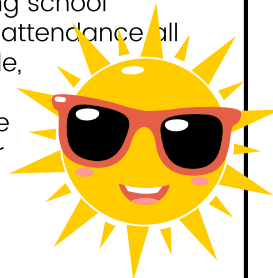
## PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

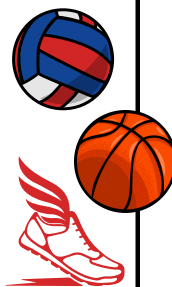
