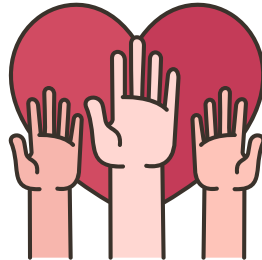

September 27th & 28th

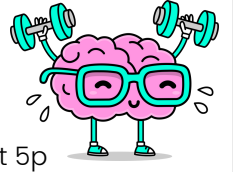
Don't forget to wear your smile! Picture day order forms will be going out later this month in student backpacks.

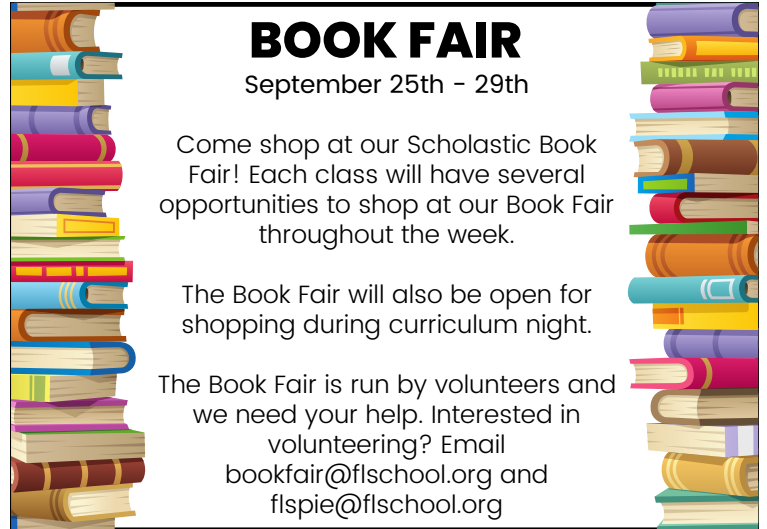
## BOOK FAIR
