Emergency Food Kit

Each student is required to bring their own pre-assembled emergency food kit to keep in their classroom for the school year. Please pack non-perishable food items in a one-gallon size Ziploc bag with your student's name written clearly on the outside.

Examples of suggested items:

- Beef Jerky
- Whole Wheat Crackers
- Nuts & Trail Mixes
- Granola Bars
- Power/Protein Bars
- Dried Fruits
- Packs of Tuna, Salmon, Chicken, or Turkey
- One family photo with a personalized note written on the back

If there is an expiration date on an item, please make sure that the date is after June 5, 2024. Please do not pack candy. Water will be provided by the school.
