Reading:

- *UFLI* is published by University of Florida Literacy Institute
- *UFLI* is an explicit and systematic program for teaching foundational reading skills
- Emphasis on phoneme blending, segmentation practice, grapheme-phoneme correspondences, explicit introduction of new concepts, decoding and encoding practice, reading and spelling irregular/heart words, and reading and spelling connected text
- *McGraw-Hill Wonders* is a common core, state aligned curriculum
- Builds reading fluency, comprehension, grammar, and vocabulary skills
- Every day chapter book read aloud

Math:

- *EnVision Mathematics* is a common core, 2020, state aligned curriculum
- Concepts include: counting, adding, subtracting, measuring, sorting, shapes, composing and decomposing numbers, and positional words
- Use of manipulatives, videos, groups lessons, and independent work to teach skills

Science:

- *Mystery Science* is a Washington State Next Generation Science Standards aligned curriculum
- Lessons offer hands-on investigations and experiments combined with interactive videos
- Units include: Plants & Animal secrets, Wild Weather, Sunny Skies, Force Olympics and Circle of Seasons.
- Includes a fun weekly question about the world around us to engage students
- Extra lessons include a variety of animal and plant studies

Social Skills:

- *Studies Weekly* is a common core, state and nationally aligned curriculum
- Units include: Community, Civics & Government, Symbols & Celebrations, Geography, Time & Chronology, History, Culture, and Economics
