Mission Statement:

Introduction:

In Pre-K, we are creating a learning environment to prepare our students academically, socially and emotionally for kindergarten and to have fun doing it.

Religion:

- Daily Jesus Time with a weekly theme using “One In Christ” curriculum
- Learning about God’s love for us and sharing God’s love.
- Recognize and appreciate God’s creation

Literacy Development:

- Identify letters of the alphabet
- Write letters of the alphabet
- Letter sounds and identifying sounds in words
- Print awareness: left to right progression, distinguishing letters, words.
- Daily stories and the enjoyment of books

Math:

- Identify and draw shapes
- Identify numerals
- Rote counting 1-31
- Counting objects 1-20
- Explore sorting, graphing, measurements using various manipulatives and classroom activities
- Exposure to math terms (add, equal, how many more, and comparative words)

Science:

- Learn about the wonder of God’s world
- Learn about various animals and their habitats with our monthly themes
- Use science tools such as magnets, scales, magnifying glasses, etc.

Social Skills:

- Learn to work, play, and share using polite words in a group setting
- Practicing patience and taking turns
- Learn to take care of his/her own basic needs: putting on a coat, using a tissue, cleaning up after themselves
- Follow directions

Creative Arts:

- Explore a variety of art processes using different mediums
- Sing traditional songs and songs that enhance the curriculum
- Participate in movement songs and dances
- Participate in dramatic play

- Special celebration days relating to letter themes (ex: Marshmallow Day, Pancakes & Pajamas Day, Letter X Day, Wacky Wednesday)

8:30	Welcome Page at Tables - And Books and Puzzles
8:35	Opening Time – Theme of the Day, Calendar; review of letters, numbers, shapes, themes; math and pre-reading activities,
8:50	Center Time – Activities throughout the room. There are teacher-led activities with individual students or small groups.
9:50	Clean Up
10:00	Jesus Time – Bible stories, singing, and prayer
10:20	Wash Hands Snack – Provided by the leader of the day Recess
10:50	Whole Group Activity – Music and movement, story time, group projects
11:15	Goodbyes – Parent pick up or student goes to Child Care
