Qty	Item
1	Backpack, full-size, brought daily
1	Binder, 2" , 3-ring, view, white (for scrapbook)
1 box	Crayola 8-color watercolor paints
1 box	Crayola colored pencils
1 box	Crayola crayons (24 count ONLY)
1 box	Crayola washable markers
1 container	Disinfectant Sanitizing Wipes (separate from art class)
8	Elmer's glue sticks
2	Erasers (Pink Pearl)
2	Folders, 2-pocket (plastic holds up better, any color BUT black)
1	Headphones or Earbuds (most kids like headphones better)
2	Highlighters (any color)
1	Oxford 3" x 5" <i>spiral bound</i> index cards, lined
1 box	Kleenex
1	Pencil sharpener, with container for shavings
1 dozen	Pencils, No. 2 Dixon Ticonderoga, sharpened
1	Pencil Box
1	Scissors (Fiskars)

Art Class Supplies – *This supply will be kept in the art classroom. Please label it ART.*

Emergency Food Kit

Each student is required to bring their own pre-assembled emergency food kit to keep in their classroom for the school year. Please pack non-perishable food items in a one-gallon size Ziploc bag with your student's name written clearly on the outside.

Examples of suggested items:

- Beef Jerky/ Whole wheat crackers
- Nuts & Trail Mixes/Granola Bars/Power/Protein Bars
- Dried Fruits/Packs of Tuna, Salmon, Chicken, or Turkey
- One family photo with a personalized note written on the back

If there is an expiration date on an item, please make sure that the date is after June 6, 2025. Please do not pack candy. Water will be provided by the school.
