Reading

Math

- *EnVision Mathematics* is a common core, 2020, state aligned curriculum
- Concepts include: addition and subtraction strategies, equal groups, place value to 1,000, mental addition and subtraction, two-digit addition and subtraction, three-digit addition and subtraction, geometry, money, measurement, time, graphs and data.
- Manipulatives make learning become "real."
- Math games reinforce learning and require cooperative learning.

Science

- Mystery Science is a Washington State Next Generation Science Standards aligned curriculum
- Units include: Animal Biodiversity, Plant Adaptations, Erosion & Earth's Surface, Material Properties
- Hands-on investigations incorporate the scientific method.
