6:00p - 8:00p

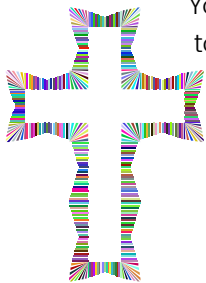
All youth, grades 5-12, are welcome to attend youth night. The evening will include some devotional time, fun activities, and open gym.

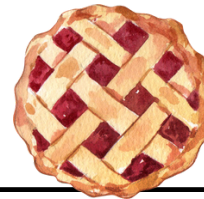


You are always welcome and encouraged to join us for chapel. If you can't make it in person, contact the school office for the live stream link.

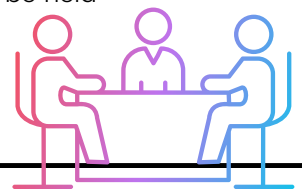
