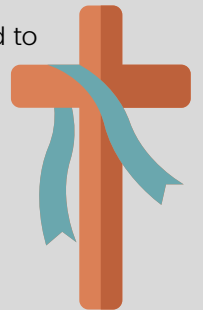
Childcare will be open during this time. Childcare students, please bring a sack lunch.

Thank you to Mrs. McMillen and Mrs. Williams for giving their time to help our girls grow in the sport of volleyball!



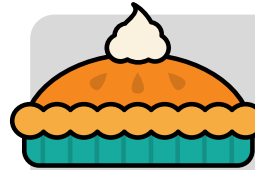
POPCORN FRIDAY
