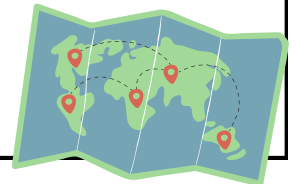

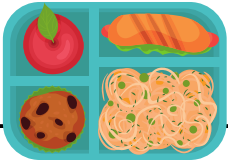

Desserts - please bring these the day of the event starting at 8:00a

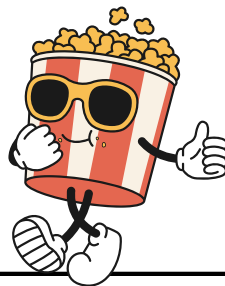


POPCORN FRIDAY
